#### 5. Zero order draft of the Annual Review on Biodiversity (9:50)

The Secretariat presented the draft recommendations for the 2025 Biodiversity Annual Review. The Committee members provided comments on the draft recommendations and the Secretariat was requested to address the comments before circulating a revised document via SharePoint for comments from the Committee members by close of business on 7<sup>th</sup> July.

It was approved for onward transmission to the Council, subject to addressing comments received from the Committee members. # 7. Thematic Session on Catchment Management and Biodiversity (10:50)

Presentations were received from Fran Igoe from LAWPRO on the roll out of the catchment management approach and John Doherty from Inishowen Rivers Trust on the use of nature-based solutions in the Clonmany Catchment in Donegal. The Committee members thanked the presenters and discussed the main points raised by the presentations.

### a) Any Other Business

Two items were discussed under any other business.

- (i) Adaptation Committee terms of reference: it was noted that the Secretariat would consider a minor review and amendment of the terms of reference of the Adaptation Committee for consideration by the Council in its September meeting. This would provide further clarity on the terms of office of members and the status of ex-officio members.
- (ii) 2026 Adaptation Workshop Topic: the Secretariat presented the list of workshop topics that were not selected in 2025 and invited members to provide any edits/amendments to existing ideas to this document by July 4<sup>th</sup>

#### b) Next Meeting

The next Committee meeting was scheduled for 11<sup>th</sup> September 2025 and is to be held inperson at the National Emergency Coordination Center in Dublin. It was noted that the Secretariat would arrange field visits for the afternoon after the meeting.
