Breakout Session 1: Sequencing of programme of work for carbon budgets

- Map out this process in terms of sequencing.



Breakout Session 2: Model Integration/Coupling

Purpose

The aim of this breakout discussion is to consider;

- The modelling carried out for the 1st CB programme.
- The development of common assumptions and scenarios in order to understand comparable model outputs where feasible.
- Identification of practical next steps and areas for research.
- Identification of steps to build capacity in this area.

Questions for consideration in breakout groups



1. The R&M Group report noted the importance of comparison of datasets, inputs, assumptions and sensitivities – how do we practically achieve this in the CB context?
2. There is more time within the 2nd CB process to look at iteration of model results, building on breakout session 1. How best to go about this?
3. How do we ensure transparent and accessible outputs?
4. How do we ensure sufficient capacity is developed and available?
5. How do we establish a process to test scenario modelling using macroeconomic analysis in relation to jobs, impacts on the economy, impacts on sectors and distributional effects?
