1. Opening of Meeting

1.1 Minutes for the Climate Change Advisory Council Meeting 31st August 2016

The minutes of the Council meeting held on the 31st August 2016 were adopted and signed by the chair.

1.2 Adoption of Agenda

The agenda for the meeting was adopted without changes.

1.3 Disclosure of Interests

There were no disclosures of interest for this meeting.

1.4 Chair's Report of Activities

The Chair outlined recommendations made by An Taisce in correspondence dated the 5th September and the subsequent response that was issued on the 3rd October.

The Chair outlined his participation at the Environment Ireland Conference on the 22nd September where he presented on 'A strategy for meeting Ireland's climate change challenge.'

The Chair reported on two meetings that took place on the 28th September:



- The Chair met with Mark Griffin, Secretary General of the Department of Communications, Climate Action & Environment. Frank McGovern of the Secretariat of the Climate Change Advisory Council was also present.
- The Chair met with IBEC's Energy Policy Committee.

The Citizen's Assembly and the national dialogue on climate change were also discussed.

2. First Report

The Secretariat provided an overview of the final draft of the First Report. Council discussed the final draft, with focus on the executive summary and recommendations within the report. A process for the finalisation of the First Report was discussed, with key timelines addressed. The Secretariat will continue to finalise the First Report with final approval to be sought by the Council in the coming weeks.

3. Adaptation

An update on the Adaptation Meeting was provided by the Secretariat, including key content for the First Report. The Council was provided with a short synopsis on the presentations made as part of the meeting.

4. Periodic Review and Report

A verbal update on the Periodic Review and Report was provided to the Council, with an update on key information gaps and identified measures on how to address these, including the issue modelling outputs (such as TRAM and COSMO) and delegated responsibility to the Secretariat to follow up on these directly. A zero order draft will be prepared and presented at the next meeting on the 8th December.

5. Analytical Framework

The Secretariat updated the Council on the Analytical Framework and the incorporation of recommendations from the previous meeting. The Council recommended that this be published as a working paper and posted on the Council's website.

6. Council Administration

The Secretariat updated the FOI arrangements of the Council, with the key roles of:
